CHANGE TO OUR ASSOCIATION'S NAME

Up to around 2009 our Association was known as The Glasshouse Mountains Zone Senior and Veterans Association. We were asked to drop the word "veterans" from our Assoc. The reasons for this change were several Zone clubs are affiliated with The Australian Veterans Association and Golf Australia implemented the categories of Masters (50-54), Seniors (55-59) and Super Seniors (60 and over) ie no Veterans group. To save confusion among our clubs then word "veterans" was dropped from the name and the Association to be known as the Glasshouse Mountains Zone Senior Golfers' Association.

In 2019 the Glasshouse Mountains Golf Zone changed its logo and this logo is now used by all sections of the Zone.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

My thanks for their knowledge, co-operation and background are extended to Eric Willett, Les Swyny and Colin Scott, as well as to those of their friends and associates who contributed to these records.

ORIGIN:

The concept for a separate competition for the senior and veteran golfers of the Glasshouse Mountains Zone, arose from Committee meetings of the Zone during 1979. At that time, Zone competition days were programmed only for those courses with 18 holes in play. There existed in the Zone, a number of "smaller" courses – those with only 9 holes in play – and there was perceived by some of the members of the Zone Board at the time, that there was bias towards the bigger clubs. To offset this and to provide a means of drawing much needed funds from the golfing fraternity of the Zone, Les Swyny who was captain of Pine Rivers at the time, proposed that there be established a nine-hole competition within the Zone. The attraction of this style of competition was seen by the ever increasing numbers of older golfers in the Zone and it was therefore decided to set up this nine-hole competition on the basis of its being for senior and veteran golfers exclusively. The proposal was supported in the first instance by those delegates representing Pine Rivers, Kilcoy, Wantima, Bribie and Beerwah, although eligibility to play in these events was open to all club players 50 years and over and handicapped within the Glasshouse Mountains Zone.

FIRST COMMITTEE:

Eric Willett, from Beerwah Club became the first President and Eric Krisanski from Woodford the first Secretary. Club delegates were: Ken Griffiths (Caboolture), Clarrie Acton (Bribie Island) J.D. Smith (Caloundra), Les Swyny (Pine Rivers) and J. Tosh (Wantima). In the history of the Association, there have only been six Presidents. Eric Willett has served two terms, Eric Krisanski, Tom Grice (Bribie Island), Eddie Boudette (Pine Rivers) and John Dillon (Wantima) each serving terms of varying duration.

FIRST COMPETITION:

The first competition was conducted at Kilcoy on March 26th, 1979 with subsequent matches at Pine Rivers (April 9), Wantima (April 23), Bribie (May 14) and Beerwah (May 28). All games were held on a Monday, starting approximately at 11.00am. The first field for the Kilcoy game numbered 35 players – all male. The championship was determined by totaling the best three gross scores returned out of the five possible. Up to and including 1990, Caloundra Club participated in the competitions as a member of this Zone. My records do not show exactly when or why the Club ceased to be a

participating member, but there is no mention of Caloundra Club in the planning or rosters from 1991 onwards.

PLAYING CONDITIONS:

Even in those times, there was no constitution drawn up and no bank account in operation. A simple set of playing conditions was decided upon and the responsibility for running the day lay with the host Club. Fees were set at \$3.00 per player of which \$1.00 went in green fees to the host Club, 75 cents competition fee went to the host Club, 25 cents were set aside for Zone trophies and \$1.00 was allocated for "lunch". Much of the earlier catering for these events was carried out by willing bands of volunteer ladies, whose mouth-watering delights are fondly remembered by those early members. 35 members contested the first event at Kilcoy and, even then, the ladies were offered no part in the actual competition. For the first two years of operation, their role was seen to act as drivers so that their menfolk could enjoy fellowship after the game. It was only later on that they were permitted to play their own 9-hole competition at the end of the men's field.

KEN GRIFFITHS SHIELD:

As a further incentive to involve ladies in the official Zone competition, it was agreed to include a Mixed Four Ball fixture in the 1982 programme. Ken Griffiths donated a shield for the event and the first such competition was conducted at Woodford on Monday, 25.07.82 with a large and competitive field vying to be the first names on the Ken Griffiths Shield. That honour went to May Hassum and Harry Whitbread from Pine Rivers Club. Following on Ken's untimely death in 1986, The Committee decided that the trophy should be known as the Ken Griffiths Memorial Shield and that it should be contested over two consecutive rounds, played at different venues. Such is the esteem in which this shield is held by members, it has been seen to be appropriate to roster the competition rounds so that all Clubs host, at least, one of the rounds within a ten year period.

ERIC WILLETT SHIELD:

To compliment the competition for a 4BBB Mixed championship, a competition for a Medley 4BBB Stableford was introduced in 1997. The competition was to be for the Eric Willett Shield in honour of the man who was one of the founding members, its first President and still a strong supporter of the Association. It is equally prestigious with the mixed event and playing conditions are the same for both shields.

PLAYING FEES:

Interestingly enough, Nomination Fees in 1979 were set at \$3.00. The fee increased to \$4.00 in 1980 and then increased to \$6.00 in 1982. It remained at this figure until Zone Board levy charges lifted the cost to \$7.00 in 2000. Further implementation of the controversial GST then set the fee at \$7.70, where it currently remains (at the time these records went to press).

In 2015 competition fees were \$13.00 per player and have risen to \$16 in 2020 and remains as is in 2023

Requirements for a Life Membership to the applicable organisation

The following description and wording for a life membership of the District or their applicable zones is to be uniform for all of the associations within the District as follows:

Honorary Life Members:

- a. On the recommendation of the Management Committee of the applicable organisation, Honorary Life Membership may be granted by resolution passed at a general meeting of that Association to any person who has rendered special services to the Association provided that:
- (i) The notice of intention to move such resolution shall have been given with the notice of the meeting. Any such resolution shall be deemed to have been defeated unless three-quarters of the Delegates present shall vote in favour of it.
- (ii) An Honorary Life Member shall be entitled to attend any Association Meeting and to speak thereat but shall not be entitled to vote except when attending as a Delegate or proxy for a Delegate.
- b. **All nominations** for Life Membership of the Associations shall be in written form with the names & signatures of the mover of the motion and is to be seconded, complete with the full description of the person's name for which Life membership is being offered and a brief description of their special services that has been rendered to that Association.
- c. The written nomination is to be presented to the Secretary, 14 days prior to any general meeting for inclusion in the agenda of the general meeting.

The above description is to be included in all Constitutions or By-Laws of all associations within the District.


